School Days: Fridays **Time:** 9:30 a.m. to 11:45 a.m.

Description: Religious education in a Montessori-style offered for children ages 4-6 (Grades JK-SK) to develop their religious potential: the capacity to love, be loved, and be in a deep relationship with God. The Parable of the Good Shepherd, the announcement of God's love through Jesus, his life, death and resurrection, and the mystery of the Eucharist form the central themes of this catechesis.

Schedule: 33 weekly school days

Autumn Term - September 13 to December 13 (*Fall Break: October 18*)

Winter Term - January 10 to March 21 (*Winter Break: February 14*)

Spring Term – March 28 to June 11 (*No School Good Friday April 18, Spring Break: May 9*)

Tuition: \$350

Class size: Maximum class size of 8 students with a 1:4 teacher to student ratio

Uniform: The school uniform is optional for this programme. Non-distracting clothing, shoes, and accessories are recommended.
